Focusing on what life was like in the mid to late 1800s at both home and school, the camps offer a unique perspective to campers on what was normal everyday life for kids 120-150 years ago. The **Little House on the Prairie Camp** will be held at the Upper City Park cabins, and the **Little School on the Prairie Camp** at the 1876 Coralville Schoolhouse (310 Fifth Street, Coralville).
